AIR FRANCE GROUND STAFF TO STRIKE ON JULY 30, 2010

Travel Resources has learned that Air France ground staff affiliated to the General Confederation of Labour (CGT) union plan to **stage a strike on 30 July** over work conditions and the proposed retrenchment of staff.

The work stoppage is likely to affect several airports across the country, particularly Orly Airport (ORY), which serves the capital Paris.

IMPORTANT NOTICE — TSA SECURE FLIGHT PROGRAM

****Failure to provide this information could result in denied boarding****

Under the TSA Secure Flight Program, the Transportation Security Administration of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) **requires the following passenger information 72 hours prior to departure.**

- ✓ All passengers must provide **Full Name, Date of Birth and Gender**
- ✓ The **data must match the data on the document presented at the airport.** More information may be obtained on the [TSA Website](#).
