MEXICANA AIRLINES SUSPENDS TICKET SALES

Mexicana Airlines, which entered bankruptcy protection this week, has stopped selling tickets, although **the airline will continue operating flights and honor existing tickets**. The airline is seeking talks with its unions as it looks to cut costs.

Mexicana's network includes routes from Mexico City to points in Canada. The parent company of Mexicana says its low-cost carriers Click and Link will continue to sell tickets.

CALGARY AIRPORT UPDATE

CALGARY International Airport (YYC) will be undergoing road paving from August 4-15.

August 4 - 13, 2010

Road pavement construction on the Arrivals and Departures roadways will cause temporary single lane closures and will affect arriving and departing airport traffic. Travelers should expect some delays and leave additional travel time for arriving and departing YYC.

August 14 - 15, 2010

Arrivals level traffic will be detoured through the Parkade 2 Connector and Through Road. Please watch for detour signs and expect some delays. Delivery trucks will not be permitted on Arrivals Level during the hours of 12h30–06h00 and 18h00–22h00. Regular height restrictions continue to apply.

****Failure to provide this information could result in denied boarding****

Under the TSA Secure Flight Program, the Transportation Security Administration of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) **requires the following passenger information 72 hours prior to departure.**

- ✓ All passengers must provide **Full Name, Date of Birth and Gender**
- ✓ The **data must match the data on the document presented at the airport.** More information may be obtained on the [TSA Website.](#)
